Subject: Institutional aspects of implementing the Dublin Convention

---

The work programme for 1994 states that the monitoring of implementation of the Dublin Convention forms a priority in the areas of action concerning asylum.

Meeting on 7 and 8 February 1994, the Group on Asylum accordingly considered the matter and in particular Article 18(4) of the Convention, under which the Committee is to determine its rules of procedure and may set up working parties.

Several delegations regarded this as a general issue, involving institutional aspects under Title VI of the TEU.

The Group agreed to refer to Steering Group I the question of how to envisage future proceedings of the Committee provided for in Article 18 of the Dublin Convention <sup>(1)</sup>.
