Presidency note
on those Articles of the Convention on which work is
to be regarded as having been completed

In view of the considerable work carried out under successive Presidencies and then speeded up under the German Presidency, culminating in the drafting of 10324/2/94 EUROPOL 112 REV 2, the Presidency-in-Office believes that, subject to amendments to make the final adjustments needed in any draft Convention, work on the following Articles is to be regarded as having been completed:

- Article 12 : Duty to notify
- Article 14a : Audit log rules
- Article 19 : Time limits for the storage and deletion of data files
- Article 23 : Data security
- Article 24 : Legal capacity
- Article 24a : Organs of Europol
- Article 26 : Director
- Article 27 : Staff
- Article 34 : Headquarters agreement
- Article 40 : Amendment of the Convention
- Article 41 : Reservations
- Article 42 : Entry into force of the Convention
- Article 43 : Accession to the Convention.

Once work on the draft Convention has been completed, the text will be approved in its entirety.
