SUPERVISION OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE EDU

Supervising the EDU's activities is the responsibility of the Council, which directs, approves or, if necessary, amends the Unit's work on the basis, inter alia, of the proceedings of the Europol Working Party.

Each Presidency will, where appropriate, lay down priorities for the EDU's activities, after assessing reports by Heads of National Units and by the EDU. Those priorities will be discussed by the Europol Working Party and approved by the Council.

Accordingly, on a six-monthly basis, the activities of the previous six months and the plans for the following six months will be assessed and approved.

With a view to making supervision and guidance of the EDU's activities more effective, the Europol Working Party may, when it considers it necessary, set up one or more subgroups.

The subgroup(s) will in each case act on the basis of a specific mandate from the Europol Working Party, in which its/their composition, specific tasks, deadlines and methods of implementation will be determined.

The results of the work carried out by the subgroup(s) will be communicated to the Europol Working Party in the manner and on the dates determined by the Europol Working Party.
