Subject: Council Resolution of 4 December 1997 on measures to  
----- be adopted on the combating of marriages of  
convenience (OJ No C 382 of 16.12.1997, p. 1).

- (2) Did you have problems in adopting those measures? If so, please state what type of problems and how you resolved them.
- (3) Do you envisage adopting measures in the areas in question in the near future? If so, what kind of measure, in which areas and with what proposed timescale?
- (4) How did you apply in practice the Resolution, apart from the adoption of internal provisions?
