HOW TO BOOK A SCHENGEN VISA Appointment?







To book an online appointment you **need a valid passport that you will use for travel** and an **email address.**

Make sure that all information provided when booking a Schengen visa appointment is correct, as later amendments are not possible.

Visa appointments are free of charge (excluding the visa fee and the service fee of the official external service provider). Consulates do not cooperate with other third party visa agencies who charge fees for booking appointments.

The booked appointment cannot be transferred to another applicant. The booking data will be checked when you submit your visa application. You will not be allowed to hand in your application if the data does not match.

WHEN?

Schengen visa applications can be lodged **already 6 months and no later than 15 days before the intended journey.** It is advisable to start the application process as early as possible.

WHERE?

At the consulate of your main destination or at an official external service provider that cooperates with this consulate, depending on the Member State. We advise against using private visa agencies, that may charge you additional fees.

HOW?

Always visit the website of the relevant consulate or of the external service provider to get information you need to follow on bookings (e.g. fill out an online form).



You must apply for a Schengen visa at the consulate of your main destination. If you apply for a visa at a consulate other than the competent one, your Schengen visa application can be rejected.
