Subject: Introduction of a standard travel document for the removal/expulsion of  
third-country foreign nationals

In its document on concertation and co-operation regarding the execution of expulsion measures (8410/94 ASIM 140), the Presidency suggests that the introduction of a standard international laissez-passer for expulsion purposes should be looked into.

The attached draft of such a laissez-passer is based on the proposal by the Greek delegation (5410/94 ASIM 54) and the draft travel document prepared by the Benelux countries and the Federal Republic of Germany. Account was also taken of a specimen document for issue to asylum applicants upon transfer in accordance with the Dublin Convention (9950/93 ASIM 7).
